

SUMMER CAMPS FOR BOYS & GIRLS GLORIETA

Permission, Consent, and Release Form

General Activities: In sending my child to camp, I understand that I am giving my child permission to participate in all activities. I am allowing my child to leave camp under supervision and to participate in the camp trips and overnight campouts. I am giving my child permission to boat in the lake, if my child chooses to do so.

Personal Property: I understand that any items my child brings to camp (i.e. cameras, athletic equipment, expensive clothing) are the responsibility of my child, and the camp is in no way responsible for lost items. The camp may use any photos or video taken of my child this summer for promotion of the camp and recruitment purposes.

Visitation: I understand that if my child is a two week camper, I will not visit, as this is disruptive to the camping process. I understand that if I do not personally pick-up my child at the end of the session, I will designate, in writing, the person or persons with whom my child will leave camp.

Medical Emergency: I hereby give my permission to the medical personnel selected by the camp director to order X-rays and routine tests and treatment for my child. In the event I cannot be reached in an emergency, I hereby give permission to the physician selected by the camp director to hospitalize, secure proper treatment for, and to order injections and/or anesthesia and/or surgery for my child. I also give permission for routine medical care for my child while attending camp.

For parents of campers that are participating in paintball: The undersigned hereby acknowledges that participation in paintball shooting games involves an inherent risk of physical injury caused by, but not limited to, falls, collision with persons or objects, being struck by projectiles or falling objects, and exertion, and assumes all such risks. Dangers related to such activities include, but are not limited to hypothermia, dehydration, heat exhaustion, heat stroke, broken bones, strains, sprains, cuts, scrapes, bruises, concussions, and heart attacks. Each participant in these activities should realize that there are risks and dangers inherent in them, and also in the training/participation in. The participant understands that in paintball games, paintballs will be fired at the participant at a high velocity. If safety equipment, such as goggles and ear protection, is not worn at all times, the risk of serious injury increases dramatically. It is the sole responsibility of each participant to participate only in those activities for which he has the prerequisite skills, qualifications, preparations and training. I understand the rules of play for the activity in which I intend to participate and will comply with all rules and regulations. If I observe any unusual or unnecessary hazard during my participation, I will bring such to the attention of the nearest official as soon as practical.

General Release: On behalf of my minor child, under 18 years of age, I hereby give permission for medical personnel to administer medical care to my minor child as necessary. I, the undersigned, on behalf of my minor child under 18 years of age, do hereby release and forever hold harmless the directors, officers, employees, agents, contractors and affiliates of LifeWay Christian Resources of the Southern Baptist Convention ("LifeWay"), Glorieta Summer Camps, from any and all claims or demands for personal injury, sickness, and death, as well as property damage and expenses, of any nature whatsoever, incurred by my minor child under 18 years of age. I further assume personal responsibility for any loss of or damage to property incurred by my minor child under 18 years of age by theft or otherwise. I also assume full personal responsibility for all medical bills for my minor child less than 18 years of age. I agree to indemnify LifeWay Christian Resources and Glorieta Summer Camps from any and all claims and demands for personal injury, sickness and death as well as property damage and expenses of any nature whatsoever incurred by my minor child less than 18 years of age due to dismissal from the event. I further hereby understand my child is covered under camp insurance for any accident or injury that occurs while in camp's care, up to the limit of camp's policy. In the unlikely event that the total amount would be more than this, my insurance will be responsible for the remainder of the bill. Illnesses are not covered under camp insurance.

This is to certify that I, as parent/guardian with legal responsibility for this minor child participant, do consent and agree not only to his release of LifeWay Christian Resources of the Southern Baptist Convention and Glorieta Summer camps, but also to release and indemnify the releases from any and all liabilities incident to his involvement in paintball for myself, my heirs, assigns, and next of kin.

Liability and Publication Release: I acknowledge and affirm that my child's participation in the camp experience ("Camp") is voluntary, and I further acknowledge that Camp involves exposure to hazards and significant risks, including the risk of property damage, serious injury and even death. My child and I recognize that my child has a choice not to participate in the Camp, but I and my child desire my child to participate in the Camp despite the risks. In exchange for my child's participation in the Camp and other good and valuable consideration, I and my child agree (a) unconditionally, absolutely, fully and forever to RELEASE, WAIVE, INDEMNIFY, HOLD HARMLESS, AND DISCHARGE LifeWay Christian Resources of the Southern Baptist Convention and its affiliates and all of their members, officers, trustees, employees, agents, representatives, insurers, successors and assigns (Released Parties) from any and all responsibility owed to my child, me, other parents and guardians of the child, our legal representatives, heirs, assigns for any and all claims, expenses, damages (including injury to person or property or death), actions, and causes of action, of whatsoever kind or nature, known or unknown, foreseen or unforeseen, arising from my child's participation in and with the Camp, including all events and activities in connection therewith, except to the extent caused by gross negligence or willful misconduct of the Released Parties, (b) that I and my child voluntarily accept and assume the risks of property damage, personal injury and death, and (c) that any photos/videos taken of my child prior to, during and/or after the event may be used for promotional purposes for this event and/or any other events. I represent that my child is physically and mentally fit to participate in the Camp.

I further acknowledge that I have carefully read the above Release, understand its contents, and I have had an opportunity to have it reviewed by an attorney, and I recognize that by signing this legally binding agreement on behalf of myself and my child and other parents and guardians of the child, we are freely giving up substantial rights and assuming risk of injury, death and/or property damage.
